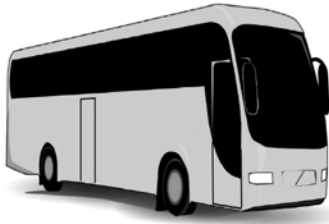

We continue to require approval for any exterior project before work begins.

COMPLAINTS- All complaints must be submitted in writing to the Code Committee with your name, address and signature. All written complaints will remain anonymous. You can obtain these forms from the Holiday Heights website or from the Association office.

NO DUMPING IN THE BASINS!

DUMPSTERS / PODS – Contact the Code Committee before planning to have a dumpster or storage pod placed in your driveway. Call Ext.#220 for details.

GARAGE/ESTATE SALE PERMITS

As per the Berkeley Township Municipal Code: Chapter 5-7.4: "The assessed owner of a property may have two (2) garage or yard sales per year. Each sale may not consist of more than two (2) consecutive days. A Berkeley Township permit is required to be obtained for each yard sale conducted.

HANDICAP RESERVED SPACES

No parking in Handicap reserved spaces without a visible license plate and ID Tag. Finable by Berkeley Township Police Department.

PARKING - Commercial vehicles are not permitted in your driveway. Parking on your lawn is also not permitted.

SPEEDING IN OUR COMMUNITY

The speed limit is **25 MPH** in residential areas. Those of you who have children living with you and who have the privilege of living here in our 55+ community are racing through our streets. Please tell them to **SLOW DOWN** and to **STOP AT STOP SIGNS**. Every day there are near misses in our community. It's not worth your life or someone else's life. **PLEASE SLOW DOWN!!**

CURBING YOUR PET- All pets must be confined within the Owner's Lot/Living Unit except when being walked on a hand-held leash, not to exceed six feet (6') in length. Pet Owners are permitted to use the

easement/patch of grass between the sidewalk and the curb. **All Pet Owners must collect their pet's feces.** Failure to pick up after your pet is a Holiday Heights fineable offense for each occurrence. There will also be an additional fine for each infraction under the Berkeley Township Ordinance (05-25-OAB-3). We expect all Pet Owners to be respectful of other Owners and in return, we expect Owners to show the same respect for Pet Owners.

GRASS CUTTING POLICY

Sprinkler heads are the Owner's responsibility

All Grass Cutting Issues must be reported to the HOA Office in writing, using the Lawn Complaint Form (forms are available at the HOA Office or on our website at (holidayheights.org)). Please do not call the Lawn Contractor or a Director. A complaint form must be filled out for all complaints. If no complaint form is filled out the complaint will be voided.

Damage to property such as siding, fences, borders and sprinklers will be addressed in a timely manner. Our contractor has staff to handle these repairs. Should you have damage, please take responsible measures to prevent further damage. All complaints will be inspected by a Director to determine the cause and action to be taken. Repairs made by homeowners prior to the Director's inspection and without authorization by the Board, will not be reimbursed. Please ensure the cutters have a clear path and your sprinkler heads are down on grass cutting days. Sprinkler heads damaged due to heads being raised during the cut cycle **will not** be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. If you have heads that do not retract, place red do-not cut flags around the head until you can have it repaired, also confirm all ground panels are secured.

Damage to lawns such as scalping and ruts will be considered on a **case-by-case** basis. Some will grow back without intervention. The majority of ruts are caused by the ground being over saturated due to recent rain and/or over watering by the sprinklers. The driver is most likely unaware of the saturated ground until it is too late. Ruts caused by Homeowners over watering their lawn will not be repaired by the Lawn Contractor. Please check your side and rear yards as needed to ensure the ground is not over saturated. If you find there are areas that are over saturated, please obtain red flags from the HOA Office and circle the saturated areas so the mowers know not to cut that area.

No Cut Signs are a violation and are subject to a fine if placed on your lawn.

"No Cut" flags are available in the HOA Office for those not wanting the Association to cut their grass. You will need to fill out the No Lawn Cut form and you will be given flags at the HOA Office. If you change your mind and decide you want your lawn cut, please remove the flags.

Under normal soil conditions, grass requires only ½ to 1 inch of water per week. Our soils are generally wetter due to the high-water table and type of soil; therefore, discuss this with your sprinkler contractor and ask them to adjust the frequency and run times on your sprinkler system for roughly ¾ inch per week. Also ask them to adjust your system as needed throughout the watering season. Remember the water requirements for the area between the homes may be less than the front and back, work with your neighbors to establish a watering schedule. Watering your lawn every day is not needed unless it is a new seeding.

Holiday Heights 2026 Pool Rules

(Our Pool Rules Supersede State Rules)

- Everyone must use personal access cards to enter the pool area including guests. No sign in is required.
- All guests must be accompanied by a Homeowner/Resident and remain with the guest while in the pool area.
- No “solo/alone” swimming. Two people must always be in or at the pool.
- Children may attend the pool between 10:00am to 12:30pm and leave the pool area by 1:00pm. A Homeowner/Resident must be present and supervise children. No children under the age of 3 are allowed in the pool.
- **No children or adult diapers including “Swim diapers, Swimmates, Swimmers, pull ups” are allowed in the pool.**
- Smoking or eating inside the pool area is not allowed.
- No alcohol or recreational drugs are allowed in the pool, pool area, or pavilion. Only plastic bottles are allowed in the pool area.
- The pool and pool area must be cleared for inclement weather and emergency situations. After 30 minutes without any thunder or lightning, you may return to the pool area.
- No shoes, flip flops, towels, goggles, or floatation devices are to be left by the steps or ladders due to safety hazard.
- Chairs, lounges, and tables may **NOT** be reserved. Tables cannot be utilized by anyone or group for all day or evening. The tables are for snacking only. Please keep the tables clean for others during the day and evening.
- All equipment, chairs, lounges, tables, noodles, etc. must be returned to their original place.
- All personal items left at the pool will be discarded at the end of the season.
- No sitting or eating on the pool steps.
- No running, jumping or diving into the pool. No pushing, shoving, rude, loud or profane language will be tolerated. If you are disruptive or refuse to follow the pool rules, you will be requested to refrain from this behavior. Refusal to refrain from this behavior will result in a Director being contacted and you be removed from the pool area. Refusal to be removed may result in a Code of Conduct violation.
- All complaints must go to a Director for a resolution or implementation.
- **If you have an open sore, infection, or diarrhea, please STAY OUT OF THE POOL.**
- Sunscreen should be applied 30 minutes before entering the pool to avoid clogging the pool drains.
- **This is a Senior Community, and we would like to keep it peaceful. Respect others.**
- **The pool will open on Memorial Day weekend and close on September 7th (extension-TBD) weather permitting. Pool Hours are 8am to 8pm unless otherwise posted.**

Forgotten History

Excerpt from History Nation
Discovery of Insulin

Before the discovery of insulin, a diagnosis of Type 1 diabetes didn't mean learning to manage a chronic condition; it likely meant preparing for an early death. Physicians had no effective treatment for Type 1 diabetes. From 1921 to 1922, that reality changed with a laboratory experiment in Toronto and rapidly became one of the most important medical breakthroughs. It transformed childhood survival across North America and beyond.

Before insulin, the only way to treat diabetes was a "starvation diet"; a low-calorie, low-carbohydrate diet which left patients severely weakened. This approach delayed death by a few months, or if lucky a few years, Children with Type 1 diabetes always meant a shortened life expectancy.

Dr. Frederick G. Banting, a Canadian surgeon,

had a breakthrough by isolating and purifying a substance produced by the pancreas. He discovered clusters of cells, called islets, produced insulin. However, these cells were destroyed with people with Type 1 diabetes.

In an experiment, by tying off the pancreatic duct in dogs, he found the enzyme-producing tissue degenerated while the insulin-producing islets remained intact. Further other experiments with animals refined the process and produced a more stable extract.

A 13-year-old boy in Toronto became the first human to be treated with insulin and had a dramatic improvement. His blood sugar levels dropped, his symptoms eased and his overall condition improved. For children who had previously faced near-certain death, insulin marked a crucial turning point in medical treatment.

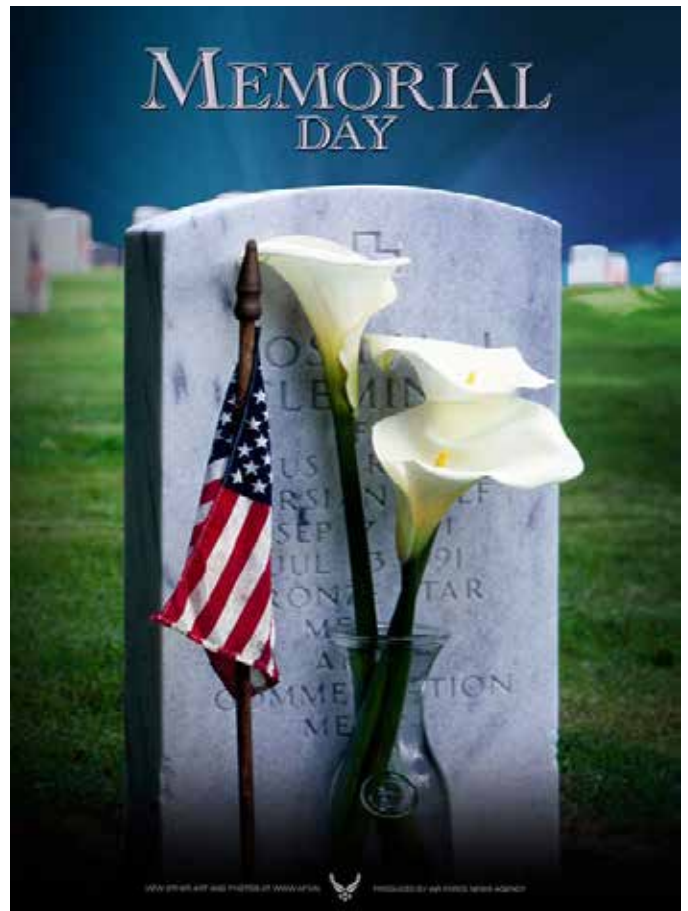

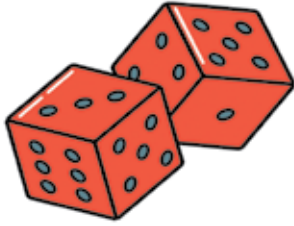

HOLIDAY HEIGHTS FIRST AID SQUAD

The Holiday Heights First Aid Squad was formed in 1987 to serve the residents of Holiday Heights. We currently work a 12-hour shift from 7 am until 1900 (7 pm). The days we work are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.

Each crew consists of an EMT or Certified Assessor, a driver/ lifter and an information specialist. Both of our ambulances are equipped with hydraulic stretchers that lift the patient into the ambulance.

There are 3 requirements to become a squad member: having a valid driver's license, getting CPR certified, and being able to get on and off the ambulance unassisted.

All crew members are certified in CPR and the use of an AED. Classes are provided in the squad

building, and all costs are covered by the squad. Members that want to be certified as an Assessor or EMT may take the required class at no cost. Drivers attend a CIVO or Advance Emergency Drivers class. Additionally, there are other classes offered by the town or County, and attendance is voluntary.

Uniform shirts and jackets are provided by the Squad. You will need black pants and black shoes.

Most Crews work two or three days per month, and we also have one mandatory meeting per month, usually the fourth Wednesday of the month.

A SHOUT OUT TO: The Quilters

Recently the Courier learned that in a quiet corner of Building #1 in the Arts & Crafts room, on Tuesday mornings you can find a group of ladies who stitch together beautiful quilts displaying the most original and unique patterns. And “Did You Know” that Lou Mangerpan can also be found sewing among the hustle and bustle filling the room!

The group was born in 1989 where Community Medical housed the quilters, who hand-made these coverlets for babies and patients in the hospital. They later moved to St. Paul’s Lutheran Church, where our own Vice President, Lorraine Petrucha, was one of three of the original members. The group worked with Ocean and Monmouth County Hospice Visiting Nurses, who sponsor the Quilters. Presently there are four women who work at the church and two work from home.

Lorraine gave us quite an extensive lesson in quilt making. There are three layers: the decorative patterned top, the batting, which is most expensive, in the center that gives the quilt its soft and cozy form, and the backing which is made of muslin or a solid-colored bed sheet may be used. They receive a stipend of \$50.00 every few months, which is spent at Michael’s Arts & Crafts on materials.

With Board approval, these 16 women, and Lou, (two or three work from home), set out on a challenging mission to continue this project to design, create, and donate their beautiful 4’ X 5’ works of art as lap blankets for patients.

With five sewing machines, a long table propped up on lifts to cut the batting, templates for the patterns, various yards of material, thread, and scissors, the quilters work like busy little bees constructing their masterpieces! The quilt is finished with a solid edging and decorative knots made by hand that form the tufting. It would take a total of six hours for one person to complete a quilt, yet they work as a team. Anyone is welcome to join, and the ladies will walk you through the process. Every two weeks a driver from Visiting Nurses picks up these works of art. Last month they donated 30 quilts and 14 memory pillows. A memory pillow is given to a teen or young child who is in Hospice care. The pillow has a clear pocket in the front where the child can display a picture of a family member, a pet, or a friend. The children will also decorate the pillow by drawing on it with fabric pens. The finished products are delivered to their new home to offer comfort and warmth to a patient in waiting.

On entering the room, one can hear the chatter of the quilters and the hum of the machines busy at work. One of the most important factors going into the creation of each quilt is the tender loving care (TLC), a by-product of friendly socializing, a key ingredient of these outstanding showpieces!
